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Narrative:

SYNOPSIS:

On 4/18/2024 at approximately 0202 hours, a white 2012 Ford F250 driven by Harrison Ludwig Ward was traveling eastbound in the westbound lanes of E. Williams Field Road at a high rate of speed when he struck a 2017 Hyundai Elantra driven by Anastasia Louise Dombrowski which was traveling westbound in the number one lane of E. Williams Field Rd just west of S. Recker Road. As a result of the collision, Anastasia suffered fatal injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene at 0202 hours. Officers at the scene observed signs and symptoms of alcohol impairment and Harrison Ward was arrested for DUI charges.

NARRATIVE:

On 4/18/2024 at approximately 0215 hours, I was contacted by Traffic Supervisor Sgt. Davis about a fatal collision that occurred on E. Williams Field near S. Recker Road. Due to being off duty at the time, I responded to the collision

scene from my residence. Upon my arrival, I observed that officers had all east and westbound Williams Field lanes closed between S. Verde Drive and S. Betty Street, along with the intersection with S. Recker Road. I observed a heavily damage Ford truck with a flatbed resting in the westbound lanes of Williams Field east of Recker Road. As I continued west on Williams Field, I observed a large debris field that continued various damaged vehicle parts and damaged streetlamps and signs. Near the intersection of Williams Field and Verde Dr, I observed a Hyundai sedan facing east in the westbound lanes with heavy driver-side damage.



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I contacted Sgt Davis at the scene, who advised initial reports from first arriving officers that the Ford truck was traveling eastbound in the westbound lanes when it impacted a Hyundai sedan just east of S. Verde Dr. After the impact, the Ford truck continued east across the intersection striking a large

streetlamp support pole before coming to rest. The driver of the Ford truck was contacted by officers and believed to have minor injuries but was highly intoxicated. The driver was transported to Chandler Regional Medical Center, where Officers are conducting a DUI investigation. The driver of the Hyundai sedan was pronounced deceased at the scene upon officers' arrival. I was also advised that Officer Valdez had been sitting near 2750 E. Williams Field Road (police property and evidence) minutes before the collision occurred and

observed a white Ford truck matching the description of the one involved in the collision, traveling east on Williams Field at a high rate of speed. Officer

Valdez estimated the white truck was traveling over 100 mph but lost sight once

he turned onto Williams Field Road. Additionally, the Hyundai sedan involved in the collision had also been called in as a suspicious vehicle earlier in the evening near the intersection of Recker and Williams Field.

Roadway:

This collision occurred on E. Williams Field Road approximately 320 feet west of S. Recker Road in the Town of Gilbert, AZ. In this location E. Williams Field Road has two lanes for east and west traffic which are divided by a center raised median plus a single bicycle lane. Due to several businesses located on the southwest corner of the intersection and their proximity to the roadway, E. Williams Field Road between S. Verde Dr and S. Recker Road has a posted speed limit of 35 mph. Streetlamps are in the center median and along

the roadway edge illuminating the roadway and sidewalks. The intersection of E. Williams Field Road and S. Recker Road is controlled by overhead traffic signals which was observed working correctly at the time.

For further details related to the roadway design see the uploaded collision scene diagrams.

Roadway Evidence:

The collision area of impact (AOI) was in the number one of westbound E. Williams Field Road approximately 275 feet west of the intersection with S.



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Recker Road. East of the AOI and continuing east across Recker Road was a debris field covering nearly all four lanes and median of Williams Field. The debris consisted of damaged vehicle parts from a Hyundai sedan and Ford F250 truck along with a large streetlamp support post. From the AOI I observe two distinct post collision paths of travel.

The first post collision path of travel was related to the Hyundai sedan which appeared to have rotated counterclockwise across the number one lane before coming to rest in the curb lane facing east. A fluid trail and roadway marks showed the Hyundai sedan was pushed east away from the AOI while rotating to its final rest location. Large vehicle parts from the Hyundai to include its roof, entire driver's side and hood were all located further east of the AOI and closer to Recker Road.

The second post collision path of travel was related to the Ford F250 which continued east in the westbound lanes before crossing over the center median near the beginning of a left turn lane. Several tire marks and gouges showed the Ford F250 had rotated and slide sideways while crossing the median and

impacted the support pole. The tire and gouge marks continue east on the median and in the left turn lane of Williams Field to the intersection with Recker Road. The tire and gouge marks continued across the intersection before reach the east center median where they paralleled the median before ending in the westbound lanes of Williams Field at the final rest location of the Ford F250.

Det. Lefler used miniature color and number coded traffic cones to mark all observed roadway evidence observed at the collision scene. Letter evidence placard were used to mark the AOI and various items of biological evidence which had been scattered throughout the scene. CST Lachcik arrived at the collision scene to take photographs of the roadway evidence, roadway design, and vehicle damage. Det. Lefler used the department's Trimble X7 and GNSS system to collect several points to document the collision scene. Using an assigned Traffic drone, I flew the entire collision scene captured several

photographs which will later be used along with the GNSS data to create a scale diagram.

Vehicle Inventory:



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2012 Ford F250 (Unit 1)

This is a white four-door 2012 Ford F250 truck with the listed current Arizona registration. The Ford F250 appeared to have been raised from factory height, and oversized tires were installed. The rear truck bed has been replaced with a steel flatbed with a large storage box. The front of the Ford truck grill, bumper, and headlight assemblies were destroyed and found within the collision scene debris field. The diesel engine intercooler and radiator had been torn from the engine compartment. The driver-side front wheel was missing and found within the debris field. The driver-side front suspension, fender, and frame rails had all been pushed inward, damaging the truck's lower suspension and drive line. The hood had been folded up during the impact, resulting in it being bent over the roof line. The driver's door had damage near the hinges, preventing it from opening at the collision scene.

The Ford F250 interior had minimal damage from the collision. Most damage was related to the airbags deploying. The driver's front and side airbags deployed along with the passenger front airbag. During the inventory of the Ford F250, Det. Sinks located in four opened 24 oz cans of Steel Reserve Spike Blue Razz on the rear passenger floorboard, along with an Apple iPhone. The open containers and phone were collected as evidence before the vehicle was turned over to the tow company to be secured in the Gilbert Police Property and Evidence Lot. For additional details related to the vehicle damage and items collected see the uploaded collision scene photographs.

2017 Hyundai Elantra (Unit 2)

This is a maroon four-door 2017 Hyundai Elantra sedan with the current listed Arizona license. The front of the Hyundai sedan was facing east, and several of the driver-side body panels were missing. The hood had been torn off and pushed into the passenger compartment. The driver-side front fender, A-pillar, front door, B-pillar, and rear door all had been torn from the vehicle. The doors and pillar were found within the debris field near Recker Road. The roof and headliner were also found east of the vehicle in the roadway debris. The rear driver-side fender was folded in on itself, deforming the trunk. The engine had separated from the driver's side and was resting on the roadway. Nearly all the driver's side of the vehicle was missing and found several hundred feet away on E. Williams Field Road.



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The Hyundai interior on the driver's side was destroyed, resulting in the steering column and dashboard being folded onto the driver's seat. The seat was broken and lying flat against the rear seat. The driver's front and side airbags were deployed during the collision event. During the inventory search of the vehicle, I located a small backpack in the passenger side front seat, which had been collected. Within the backpack, I located Anastasia's driver's license and wallet, which were returned to the family. The vehicle was turned over to the tow company to be secured in the Gilbert Police Property and Evidence Lot. For additional details related to the vehicle damage and items collected see the uploaded collision scene photographs.

Witness Statements:

John Septer

While Officers were at the scene, they contacted John Septer, who identified himself as the boyfriend of the woman driving the Hyundai sedan. This was confirmed based on Officer Valdez's earlier call for service, where he contacted and identified both John and Anastasia Dombrowski sitting in the listed Hyundai sedan. Due to the exact vehicle identified during Officer Valdez's call being the same one involved in the collision, John was contacted

by Officer Wright to provide information about his and Anastasia's interactions before the collision. While speaking with Officer Ca. Wright, John stated that Anastasia had just dropped him off at his residence about five minutes before the collision happened. John was standing on his apartment balcony when he heard tires screeching in the distance and saw one of the involved vehicles traveling eastbound on E Williams Field Rd. John ran to the scene, which was when Gilbert Police contacted him.

While at the collision scene, I contacted John Septer, who was with Officers in the parking lot on the southwest corner of the intersection. The following is a brief synopsis of my conversation with John, conducted in my vehicle and

recorded using my BWC. For the exact verbiage used, see the uploaded footage on evidence.com. John had been dating Anastasia for about two months, and they had been out earlier in the evening. They had been in Mesa early and returned to



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his residence, where they sat in the back of her vehicle talking for some time. He stated that due to them sitting in the running vehicle for so long, someone had called the police, who showed up and contacted them. Around 0140 or 0150 hours, Anastasia left for home in Phoenix while John went into his apartment. John went out on his balcony to make sure she made it onto the road, where he saw her vehicle pass through the intersection, traveling west on Williams Field. After seeing her vehicle pass, he turned to go back into his apartment when he heard screeching tires and saw a vehicle going east through the intersection. He attempted to call Anastasia, but after getting no answer, he ran to the collision scene and observed that her vehicle was involved.

During the conversation, John stated that while they were out earlier in the evening, Anastasia wasn't drinking or known to use any illegal drugs. He knows she took medication for headaches along with having an [REDACTED]. After speaking with John, I provided him with my contact information before releasing him to his mother, who had arrived at the scene.

Patrick Wheeler

While at the collision scene, a witness contacted the Gilbert Police Department to report they observed the white truck driving the wrong way on Williams Field Rd and may have video. Officer Winfrey and ITO Morgan contacted the witness, who they identified as Patrick Wheeler. The following is a brief synopsis of their conversation. See OTI Morgan supplement report and BWC footage for the exact verbiage used. Patrick had just completed a delivery at the Frys Marketplace located at Williams Field and Recker. Patrick had made a left-hand turn from Recker onto E. Williamsfield and began traveling west when he first noticed headlights in the distance. The headlights appeared to him to be from a vehicle driving towards him in the westbound lanes. Patrick changed into the number one lane and observed the vehicle approaching the wrong way, doing the same. At this time, Patrick determined that the approaching vehicle was traveling in the westbound lanes and heading eastbound. Patrick again made another evasive maneuver, changing into the number three lane, when a "work truck" passed by him traveling around 80 mph. Patrick assumed the "work truck," traveling in the wrong direction, must have turned since it didn't see it strike anything after it passed his location near the railroad tracks.

Patrick advised Officers that his work truck was equipped with a dash camera, but he couldn't access it. Patrick provided contact information for his business before ending the conversation. I contacted Patrick's manager and



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requested any available video from Patrick's vehicle on the night of the collision. I was advised they would look for any video, but several of their fleet trucks' cameras were inoperable. If and when video footage is obtained, an additional supplement report will be completed.

Drivers:

Harrison Ludwig Ward (Unit 1)

Harrison was contacted by Officer Valdez, still sitting in the driver's seat of his Ford F250 truck, which was located east of S. Recker Road in the westbound lanes of E. Williams Field Road. Once Harrison was out of the vehicle and sitting on the sidewalk, Officer Valdez stated he smelled a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his person. Harrison's initial statements to Officer Valdez were that he was unaware of how the collision happened. While

Harrison was being transported by Gilbert Medic 251, he made various statements about drinking all day and that he shouldn't have been driving. Upon reviewing Officer Valdez's BWC footage, I observed Harrison was in the driver's seat of the vehicle, which was still turned on, and he was the only occupant. During his interactions with Officer Valdez, Harrison's speech was slurred, and his movements were observed to be slow and lethargic. See Officer Valdez's supplement report and BWC footage for further details related to their interactions.

Gilbert Fire treated Harrison at the scene before being transported to Chandler Regional Medical Center. Officer A. Templeton responded to conduct a DUI investigation. During his DUI investigation, Officer A. Templeton smelled the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from Harrison, along with his visibly bloodshot and watery eyes and slurred speech. Based on the observed signs and symptoms of impairment and details related to the collision events, Officer A. Templeton obtained a search warrant to collect two blood samples from Harrison. Once the search warrant was obtained and served, Officer Templeton conducted the DUI interview, during which Harrison admitted to

drinking. See Officer Templeton's supplement report and BWC footage for further details about his interactions with Harrison.

Harrison remained at Chandler Regional Medical Center while being treated for his injured right ankle. Medical staff advised that due to his high BAC, additional testing to check for neck injuries was being delayed. Officers remained at the hospital until Harrison was medically cleared and released. At



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approximately 1143 hours, Officer Kells placed Harrison under arrest and transported him to the Gilbert/Chandler Unified Holding Facility, where he was turned over to me. For further details about Officer Kells's interaction with Harrison, see his supplement report and BWC footage.

While in the detention processing area, I contacted Harrison to speak with him about the collision. After confirming that Harrison understood his rights, I asked if he wanted to speak with me. Harrison initially stated he had nothing to say and didn't remember what happened. I clarified with Harrison his statements about nothing to say, and he again stated he genuinely doesn't remember anything. I asked Harrison about his earlier statements to Officer Templeton about what he did before the collision. Harrison said he had the day off work and went to Top Golf. He stated he went to Top Golf around 1845 hours and left around 2200 hours. He was drinking with a co-worker and didn't remember how many "Captain and Cokes" he had. Harrison made the statement that sometime between leaving Top Golf and now, he "fucked up." Harrison works in construction in the metro area and has been staying with his family in Apache Junction, but he wasn't sure if that was where he was going. During the

conversation, Harrison advised that he has a drinking problem and drinks daily. When asked again about the events before and during the collision, Harrison said all he remembers is leaving Top Golf and waking up in the hospital.

After speaking with Harrison, I informed him of the details of the collision and the charges he was being arrested on. I explained to him the next steps in the process before ending my BWC recording to begin the questions about the booking process. The MCSO booking process was completed, and Harrison was turned over to the detention staff.

Anastasia Louise Dombrowski (Unit 2)

First arriving Officers located a single female occupant partially ejected from a heavily damaged Hyundai sedan, which was facing east in the westbound lanes

of Williams Field Road. Officers observed that the female occupant had suffered fatal injuries and was pronounced deceased at that time. Using the vehicle license plate, information from an earlier police contact, and witness statements, Officers tentatively identified the female occupant as Anastasia Louis Dombrowski. This was later confirmed by personal vehicle items and an Arizona driver's license. Due to injuries Anastasia suffered during the collision, a visual identification using her driver's license was not able to be done. However, based on the information already known, attempts began to contact Anastasia's next of kin. The vehicle license for the Hyundai sedan



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Anastasia was found in was listed to both her and an individual named Byron Dombrowski, who I believed was her father. Based on this information, I request that Sgt. A. Davis contact the Phoenix Police Department to attempt to contact her next of kin. See Sgt. Davis's supplement report for details related to next of kin notification.

The Maricopa County Medical Examiner's Office Investigator Espinoza #87 arrived at the scene at 0638 hours. Anastasis was removed from the vehicle, photographed, and turned over to the Medical Examiner. For further details related to injuries Anastasia suffered, see OME report 24-03982.

Phoenix PD notified Byron Dombrowski before he contacted me via telephone at the scene. I provided him with details about the known facts of the collision, along with information related to the Medical Examiner's Office.

Lab Analysis:

Officer Templeton drafted, obtained, and served a search warrant to collect two blood samples from Harrison while he was being treated at Chandler Regional Medical Center. The blood samples were secured into evidence and sent to the Mesa Crime lab for analysis.

While at Chandler Regional Medical Center, Officer Templeton was advised by staff that a medical blood sample collected and sent to their lab returned with a blood alcohol concentration (BAC) of 0.275.

Speed Calculations:

The speed calculations conducted using the post-collision distances traveled by the Ford F250 showed it traveling between 100 to 103 mph when it struck the Hyundai Elantra in the westbound lanes of E. Williams Field Road. The posted speed limit on E. Williams Field Road in this location is 35 mph.

Video Evidence:



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During the investigation, three videos were obtained from nearby businesses and homes, which capture portions of the event leading up to and after the collision. Upon reviewing the video evidence, I determined that the Ford F250 had been traveling eastbound in the westbound lanes of E. Williams Field Road before impacting the Hyundai sedan.

Additionally, the videos show the excessive and extreme speeds at which the Ford F250 traveled before and after the impact. All video evidence was uploaded to evidence.com.

CONCLUSION:

On 4/18/2024 at approximately 0202 hours, a white 2012 Ford F250 driven by Harrison Ludwig Ward was traveling eastbound in the westbound lanes of E. Williams Field Road at a high rate of speed when he struck a 2017 Hyundai Elantra driven by Anastasia Louise Dombrowski which was traveling westbound in the number one lane of E. Williams Field Rd just west of S. Recker Road. As a result of the collision, Anastasia suffered fatal injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene at 0202 hours.

Officers at the scene who contacted Harrison Ward observed signs and symptoms of impairment by alcohol. Harrison Ward was transported to Chandler Regional

Medical Center for treatment, where Officer Templeton obtained a search warrant to collect a blood sample from him. Officer Templeton was advised by medical staff that blood results from their hospital draw showed Harrison's blood alcohol concentration (BAC) was 0.275. Harrison made statements to Officer

Templeton that he had been drinking double rum and cokes at Top Golf in Gilbert until 2200 hours. When asked about the collision, Harrison said he had been traveling 45 mph and driving around without any known destination. Four 24 oz Steel Reserve beer cans were observed on the rear floorboard of Harrison's truck at the collision scene.

Roadway evidence at the collision scene showed Harrison was traveling well above the posted 35 mph speed limit for E. Williams Field Road between S. Verde Dr and S. Recker Road. Witnesses and obtained video evidence confirmed Harrison had been traveling at a high rate of speed eastbound in the westbound lanes of



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E. Williams Field since the railroad crossing, which is approximately a half mile west of the collision location. Additionally, after the collision with Anastasia's vehicle, Harrison's vehicle continued east for 567.51 feet,

crossing the center raised median twice while striking various large streetlamp support posts and numerous other street signs. Preliminary speed calculations conducted using just the post-collision distance Harrison showed the Ford F250 truck would have been traveling at a minimum speed between 100 to 103 mph in the posted 35 mph when he impacted Anastasia's vehicle.

Based on the preliminary investigation findings, Harrison Ludwig Ward was placed under arrest at 1143 hours and booked into the Gilbert/Chandler Holding Facility for the following charges:

ARS 13-1104: Second-degree murder based on Harrison Ward's actions manifesting extreme indifference to human life while recklessly engaging in conduct that resulted in the death of Anastasia Louis Dombrowski.

ARS 28-1383A5: Aggravated DUI based on Harrison Ward operating a motor vehicle on a roadway with a BAC of 0.275 while driving the wrong way on a roadway.

Further investigation is needed to confirm an exact speed the Ford F250 was

traveling before the collision which will be completed using CDR data collected from both vehicles. Additionally, the blood sample collected from Harrison was sent to the Mesa Lab for Analysis and once results return will be forwarded to the MCAO.

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Narrative:

On 4/18/2024 at approximately 0202 hours I self-attached to a reported unknown injury collision at the intersection of S. Recker Rd / E. Williamsfield Rd.

While enroute, the first officer on scene, Officer Valdez, requested traffic in all directions be diverted. I responded to the listed intersection code three from my previous call for service.

Once I arrived on scene, I positioned my fully marked patrol vehicle with all emergency lights initiated to block southbound traffic on Recker Road, North of the listed intersection. Southbound traffic was being diverted onto adjacent side streets.

I proceeded on foot to the scene where I was tasked with interviewing two potential witnesses.

I interviewed Taliah Elize Carpenter-Cayce, who was found standing near the accident scene. Taliah was identified utilizing her Arizona Drivers license. Taliah stated that she did not witness the accident; however, when she arrived at the accident an officer was already on scene. Taliah had nothing to add to the investigation.

Taliah was accompanied by her boyfriend who verbally identified himself as Giovanni Ramos and later confirmed utilizing his MVD record. Giovanni was also



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located at the scene and had nothing to add to the investigation.

Both Taliah and Giovanny were released from the scene shortly after obtaining their contact information.

During the collision investigation, new information was provided to Gilbert Police stating a delivery driver for Taylor Farms Southwest made a delivery near the listed intersection around the time of the collision, and can provide dashcam footage showing a vehicle driving the wrong direction on Williamsfield Rd.

The driver was later identified as Patrick Wheeler, confirmed utilizing his MVD record. Patrick provided his contact information to Gilbert Police Dispatch, who passed along his contact information to the police units working the collision investigation.

I volunteered to provide Patrick with a Community Request Axon Link to allow him access to upload his footage to a secure location where Gilbert Police Traffic Reconstruction Detectives the ability to review his evidence.

I contacted Patrick via Telephonic communication ([REDACTED]) at approximately 0537 hours on 4/18/2024. The following is a summary of my interview with Patrick over the phone:

Patrick stated he completed a delivery at approximately 0158 hours at the Frys

Marketplace located at the listed intersection of the collision. He then made a left hand turn from Recker Rd onto E. Williamsfield Rd headed westbound. Once Patrick established himself heading westbound he noticed in the distance headlights that appeared to be a vehicle driving towards him traveling against traffic. Patrick stated he made a lane change into the number one lane and described the vehicle traveling in the wrong direction made the same adjustment. Patrick confirmed at this point he determined a vehicle was traveling in the westbound lanes, heading eastbound. At approximately 0202 hours, Patrick made another evasive maneuver by changing lanes into the number

three lane when a "work truck" (Patrick's words) passed by him traveling at his estimation of 80mph at least. Patrick described two other vehicles that were traveling behind him he showed concern for, and pulled over to make sure they were not involved in a collision with the wrong way driver. He stated he



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assumed the driver traveling in the wrong direction must have turned northbound onto Recker. My phone call with Patrick ended with him stating he would be unable to personally upload the dash cam footage and provided me with the contact information for whom would be able to help access the footage. That contact information was relayed to the detectives on scene.

I remained on scene and provided scene security until I was relieved by another unit.

On the listed date and time of the incident, I was the field training officer (FTO) for Ofc. Morgan. We responded to this call for service from the area of E Pecos Rd and S Market St. Based on information provided by police already on scene, Ofc. Morgan initiated his emergency lights and sirens to respond.

Upon arrival, we diverted all southbound traffic on S Recker Rd at E Haskell St

We then were tasked to interview subjects around the scene of collision to determine their involvement. I spoke to a subject (Ethan Venjohn) who stated he did not witness the collision and arrived after the fact. Ethan had nothing to add to the investigation.

Sometime later, Ofc. Morgan and I were tasked with contacting an alleged witness via telephone. We spoke to Patrick Wheeler (identified by MVD records). The following is a summary of the phone conversation with Patrick, please refer to BWC for exact phrasing: Patrick is a truck driver for Taylor Farms Southwest and had finished a delivery at the Fry's Marketplace located at 4075 E Williams Field Rd. Patrick left the parking lot at approximately 0158 hours and turned into the #2 lane of westbound Williams Field Rd from Recker Rd. Patrick noticed in the far distance (he estimated in the area of S Higley Rd and E Williams



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Field Rd) a set of headlights which appeared to be coming towards him in the wrong lane of travel. As Patrick continued westbound on Williams Field, he moved into the #1 lane of travel. He noticed the vehicle in question was indeed traveling wrong-way and was eastbound in the westbound lanes of Williams Field.

Patrick now estimated the vehicle to be approximately one-half mile to one mile away based on the description he gave of his truck's location. Patrick stated he thought the vehicle was trying to purposefully hit him with their vehicle because anytime he changed lanes the vehicle also changed lanes. At

approximately 0202 hours, Patrick moved into the #3 lane of travel when a "work truck" passed him going eastbound in the westbound lanes of travel. Patrick

estimated the speed of the truck to be at least 80 mph. Patrick slowed down to see if the truck had struck any of the vehicles that were behind him traveling

westbound. Patrick did not see any collision and assumed the vehicle had turned on Recker Rd. Patrick stated his truck is equipped with a dash came to the front and to the rear and would have recorded the incident. One can was located in the middle area of the rear passenger floorboard, directly behind the middle armrest console equipment, and was open/unsealed and essentially empty. At the time of this inspection, it was not cool to the touch. Immediately adjacent to the right of this can, was a tied up gray plastic bag with two more Steel

Reserve cans, also open/unsealed and empty. The last open/unsealed can of Steel Reserve was also on the rear passenger floorboard, but on the far right and essentially again the right rear passenger door. These other three cans were

not cool to the touch upon this inspection. Some of the cans had a trace amount of liquid inside, able to be heard when shook lightly. The contents smelled of an alcoholic beverage upon inspection. The cans were seized and placed in separate bagging, one for each item as it was found. CST Lachcik retained the items and later impounded them as evidence into the property unit.

I also assisted by making telephonic contact with an involved subject, Patricia Pacolak, who called the PD about having video footage of the collision. Miss

Pacolak relayed she woke up hearing sirens which were responding to this crash. She advised she lives just north and east of the intersection and walked down

to the scene in the minutes after it occurred, but was turned away by police on



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scene. She stated upon coming home and reviewing her Ring camera footage, since her home faces toward Williams Field Rd, portions of the collision are able to be seen and heard. I sent an evidence.com link to her cell phone via Axon Citizen for the file to be uploaded to the GPD evidence.com cloud. I later verified the file was uploaded and relayed this information to Det. Delleart.

I further assisted with helping pickup/clean up the scene from the evidence marking equipment prior to clearing from the area.

This is the end of my involvement in this matter at this time.

On 04/18/2024 at approximately 0646 hours, I was dispatched to this incident to assist officers that were working a fatal vehicle collision. I was instructed by Sergeant Madueno to respond to Chandler Regional Hospital to relieve Officer A. Templeton who had been standing by with the suspect, Harrison Ward.

Upon my arrival, I located Officer Templeton and Harrison at Emergency Room #20. Harrison was laying on a hospital gurney and appeared to be sleeping. Harrison was covered with a blanket and was wearing a neck brace.

Officer Templeton told me that Harrison had been involved in a fatal collision during the night and was intoxicated by alcohol. Officer Templeton told me that hospital staff was waiting for Harrison to become more sober so they could further evaluate his condition before releasing him. I was told to stand by with Harrison until he was released from the hospital so he could be transported to the jail to be booked for his charges.

While waiting at the hospital with Harrison, I sat directly outside of his room where I was able to keep a visual of him through the glass doors. During this time, I spoke briefly with Harrison's nurse, Ryan Tiffany. Ryan told me that they were waiting for Harrison to become sober so they could remove his neck brace and appropriately evaluate his neck before releasing him. Ryan also

stated they performed a CT scan to Harrison's left leg, which revealed he had a fracture to the bottom of his left tibia and the top of his left foot near the base of his ankle.



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From approximately 1115 hours to 1135 hours, I was briefly relieved by Officer Norero while I took a break.

When I returned to the hospital, Harrison was in the process of getting discharged. I spoke briefly with nurse Ryan Tiffany again who advised Harrison had been given a brace for his left ankle and that he was medically cleared to be released to our custody.

I activated my body worn camera and placed Harrison under arrest at 1143 hours. I read Harrison his Miranda Warnings verbatim from my department Miranda Warning card at 1143 hours and he stated "Yes sir" when asked if he understood his rights.

I then transported Harrison to the Gilbert jail where he was turned over to Detective Delleart at approximately 1230 hours. The transport to the jail was recorded on both my body camera and the AXON Fleet cameras from the patrol car I was driving (vehicle #2905).

On April 18, 2024, at approximately 0202 hours, I was dispatched to the listed intersection regarding an unknown collision call for service. Upon arrival, I observed two vehicles which appeared to be involved in a collision: a red vehicle west of the intersection and a white truck east of the intersection. I proceeded to the west of the intersection and observed the red vehicle with a female on the ground, not responsive or breathing. Due to the female not appearing to display any signs of life (significant head injury), I proceeded

to the other vehicle involved. The red vehicle had severe damage to the point I was able to observe the interior of the vehicle and nobody else inside the vehicle. Based on a previous contact with the vehicle and a female who was identified via her Arizona State driver license, Anastasia Dombrowski was the female on the ground wearing the same clothing description, unresponsive.

GI 24-55134 - E HASKELL ST / S SWALLOW LN

At approximately 0143 hours, I spoke with Anastasia Dombrowski and her boyfriend, John Septer, inside a red Hyundai Elantra (), talking in the backseat. Anastasia and John were identified via their Arizona State driver's license.

I proceeded to the white truck and observed a male, later identified via his Arizona State drivers license as Harrison Ward, in the driver's seat and asked if he was okay, to which he responded he was good and did not have any injuries. Harrison's driver's door was caved in, and he was unable to open the door. I told Harrison to try the passenger door, but it was not operational, and he climbed out the passenger window. I assisted Harrison out of the window to which he mentioned his left ankle was hurting. I told Harrison to have a seat on the curb until the Gilbert Fire Department could evaluate him further.



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I asked Harrison if he had a driver's license, and he handed it to me. Harrison was unaware of what occurred when asked how the collision happened. Due to Harrison's injuries, the Gilbert Fire Department transported him to Chandler Regional Hospital for further treatment. While speaking with Harrison, an odor of an alcoholic beverage was emitting from his person. Harrison was the sole occupant inside his truck when I arrived.

It should be noted while at Property (Stationary // 2750 E WILLIAMS FIELD RD), I observed a white truck traveling at a high rate of speed, which I visually estimated to be approximately 100MPH. I attempted to catch up to the vehicle,

but once I went onto East Williams Field Road, I lost sight of the white truck. The white truck had a black flatbed, which was consistent with what I observed traveling at a high rate of speed.

I followed the ambulance to Chandler Regional Hospital and stayed with Harrison until Officer Templeton relieved me. I did not speak with Harrison while he was at the hospital.

GILBERT MEDIC 251

Upon arrival, Paramedic Nick R informed me Harrison had made statements inside the ambulance and wanted me to be aware. Axon Capture was utilized to take a picture of the notes. The following is what Paramedic Nick R wrote down regarding Harrison's statements:

"I was too fucked up"

"They shouldn't have let me drive"

"I drank all day yesterday"

"I drank two tall cans, fell asleep, wake up, drink two more, fell asleep"

On 04/18/2024, at approximately 0202 hours, I was conducting uniformed patrol in a fully marked Gilbert Police vehicle. I was dispatched to a call for service reference an unknown injury collision in the area of Recker and Williams Field. Prior to arriving on scene I heard Officer Valdez advise over police radio that the collision involved a fatality and he needed all traffic

stopped from entering the scene. Upon hearing this radio traffic I activated my emergency overhead lights and siren and responded "code 3" to the scene.

I was the next officer to arrive on scene and I positioned my patrol vehicle to the East of the intersection, blocking all westbound traffic. I set up cones and flares to force all westbound traffic to either turn left into the Fry's

Grocery parking lot or to make a u-turn. I then walked on foot to the collision scene to provide whatever assistance necessary.

I briefly looked at a damaged pickup truck, I did not enter the vehicle. From outside the vehicle I was able to see that the seatbelt for the driver's seat was locked forward. No other seatbelts were locked forward but were all locked back indicating they were not restraining somebody during the collision. There were no people inside the vehicle when I approached and no evidence of ejected occupants.

I was directed to begin setting up crime scene tape around the other involved vehicle (a red Hyundai passenger car) that was on the West side of Recker, on Williams Field. An inner crime scene area was taped off around the Hyundai and the deceased driver. I initiated a Crime Scene Log. I remained on scene



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security around this inner crime scene until I was relieved of my position by Officer Carrigan. Officer Carrigan assumed his own Crime Scene Log when I departed the scene.

As I was leaving the scene, a business owner from a nearby business lifted up crime scene tape and stepped under it. He was ordered out of the scene and back behind the tape. He did not enter the roadway, but he did step under the tape briefly. He asked to open his business (which was blocked with crime scene tape). He was told that the front door of his business was included within the crime scene and could not be opened until after the investigation was completed and detectives reopened the area.

I photographed my Crime Scene Log (which consisted of one, single sided page) and uploaded the image to AXON Capture. The original copy of this log was impounded into Gilbert Police Property.

I had no additional involvement.

On 04-18-2024 at approximately 0202 hours I responded to the area of E

Williams Field Rd / S Recker Rd to assist with a fatal collision investigation. While enroute, Officer Valdez advised one of the drivers, later identified to me as Harrison Ward by Arizona driver license, was very intoxicated. Prior to my arrival, Harrison was transported to the Chandler Regional Medical Facility for evaluation and treatment of a possible fractured leg and ankle. Officer Valdez was reported to be following behind the ambulance in which Harrison was being transported to the hospital.

I arrived on scene of the collision to obtain further information regarding the details of the collision. A short preliminary walk of the scene revealed the white Ford F250 driven by Harrison was traveling eastbound on Williams Field Rd at the time of the collision with a maroon Hyundai Elantra which was traveling westbound on Williams Field Rd. The driver of the Hyundai, later identified to me as Anastasia Dombrowski, was pronounced deceased on scene. Based upon the amount of damage to both vehicles, the large debris field, and length of the collision scene it appeared excessive speeds were involved leading up to the events of the collision. After walking the scene of the collision, I responded to the Gilbert-Chandler Unified Holding Facility to obtain two sealed blood kits for collection of samples from Harrison while at the hospital.

I responded to Chandler Regional where I met Officer Valdez outside of the CT scan room in the emergency room area. It was there that Officer Valdez



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provided me with an update on Harrison's condition. Harrison was observed to be wearing a neck brace for precautionary reasons due to the collision and the marks on his neck from the seatbelt. No apparent major apparent injuries were

visible and it was believed there may be a fracture of Harrison's left leg, but evaluation was still ongoing. Harrison was conscious as his gurney was moved from the CT scan room to treatment room #20 where he was placed. A strong odor of an alcoholic beverage was noted to be coming from Harrison's person. Harrison's eyes were visibly bloodshot and watery in appearance when Harrison opened his eyes partially while talking to hospital staff. At times Harrison's speech was noted to be slurred as he answered various medical questions by hospital staff.

Officer Valdez advised me that he was in the area of the Gilbert Police Property and Evidence building located at 2750 E Williams Field Rd. It was then that Harrison's vehicle was reported to have passed by Officer Valdez while traveling what he estimated to be 100 MPH while eastbound on Williams Field Rd. Officer Valdez reported that he attempted to follow Harrison's vehicle in an attempt to catch up to the vehicle which was much further east of his location by the time he began to follow. As Officer Valdez was near the intersection of Williams Field Rd / Higley Rd the call about the collision at Recker Rd was being received and dispatched. Officer Valdez advised he arrived on scene of the collision a short time later and found Harrison to be seated in the driver's seat of the Ford F250. Officer Valdez provided me with Harrison's Arizona driver license. During Harrison's treatment by Gilbert Fire, Officer Valdez advised Harrison made admissions of consuming several alcoholic beverages and to being "fucked up." Reference Officer Valdez's supplement for further details.

I drafted a nighttime electronic search warrant to obtain two separate blood samples from Harrison, each occurring approximately one hour apart. The Honorable Tracy Nadzieja of the Maricopa County Superior Court contacted me by phone and advised she was granting the search warrant (SW2024-058670). A copy of the signed warrant was printed and then served to Harrison at approximately 0336 hours. The copy of the search warrant was later left with Harrison's personal belongings. Copies of the search warrant related documents have been attached to this report.

Prior to completing the draws approval from the medical staff treating Harrison was obtained to remove the blood pressure cuff from Harrison's right arm each time. I drew 2 tubes of blood from Harrison's right antecubital fossa



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at approximately 0342 hours without incident. Harrison was advised of his right to an independent test. The blood kit was packaged and sealed before being temporarily secured in my patrol vehicle until it could later be impounded. A second draw was later completed at approximately 0442 hours from Harrison's right antecubital fossa without incident. The second kit was packaged, sealed, and labeled as draw #2. I retained the blood kit in my possession until later

impounding the blood kit after being relieved from my position at the hospital. The blood kits will be sent to the Mesa Police Department for scientific analysis.

At approximately 0400 hours I advised Harrison of his Miranda warnings, after which he replied "yeah" when asked if he understood his rights.

Interview with Harrison Ward:

Harrison was first asked where he was coming from prior to the collision.

Harrison thought briefly before replying, "drinking." I asked Harrison where he was drinking and he advised he was drinking at a bar, but could not remember

where specifically. I attempted to clarify the general area of the bar in order to determine where Harrison may have been coming from, but he advised he did not know. I asked Harrison if he remembered what direction he was traveling before the accident as well as where he was driving to prior to the collision. Again, Harrison advised he did not know. Harrison advised he has been living out of hotels and motels while working in the construction field, but provided little other details. When asked to describe his driving prior to the collision, Harrison replied, "just driving." I asked Harrison if he knew how fast he was traveling at the time of the collision at which time Harrison replied, "no." When asked if he could estimate how fast he may have been traveling at the time of the collision, Harrison replied, "45." Harrison reported he was wearing his seatbelt at the time of the collision. Harrison denies the use of any medications or drugs in the past 24 hours, but admits to having smoked a friend's THC vape pens several days prior to the collision.

Harrison advised he woke up at approximately 1600 hours, stating he had "a lot" of sleep. When asked how much "a lot" meant to him, Harrison advised it was over 12 hours. Harrison advised he began drinking at approximately 1900 hours and finished at approximately 2230 hours. I asked Harrison where he had been drinking and he replied, "Top Golf." I clarified if he had anything to drink

earlier in the evening as well as at any other locations. Harrison confirmed he only drank at Top Golf. Harrison advised he had approximately three Captain & Cokes. I asked Harrison about the sizes of the drinks he consumed, which he admitted were probably doubles. When asked the total number of drinks he



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consumed in the last hour prior to the collision, Harrison advised he had approximately four drinks. Based upon this answer I again asked Harrison how much he had to drink. Harrison again advised he had four drinks. Harrison was asked to rate himself on a scale of 0 to 10 with a zero being completely sober and a 10 being completely intoxicated. Harrison rated himself as a 0 on that scale at both the time of the interview and the time of the collision. I asked Harrison if he would go to work in his current condition as well as the condition he was in at the time of the collision. Harrison first advised he would not due to the fact he was in the hospital bed. When asked if it were not for the fact he was in the hospital if he would go to work, Harrison advised he would not. Harrison denied feeling buzzed or any effects of the alcohol at the time of the collision. Harrison reported he has previously been arrested for a DUI in 2020 in Lake Havasu. Harrison advised he was convicted and had a blood alcohol concentration of 0.154 during that incident. Harrison advised he believes he has a valid license and an active insurance policy with Progressive

I remained at the hospital until relieved by Officer Kells at approximately 0720 hours. Officer Kells was provided with an update on Harrison's condition and advised of the staff members providing treatment should he need any additional information updates. After leaving Chandler Regional I drove to the San Tan Substation where I impounded both blood kits into the evidence refrigerator.

No further involvement.

Williams Field and Recker. I was asked to respond to our San Tan substation to collect the requisite diagramming equipment before responding to the scene.

I later arrived on scene and consulted with Detective Delleart regarding the known facts of the investigation. I was asked to identify and mark roadway evidence and collect GNSS data points and 3D scans.

Using mini color/number coded cones, I identified and marked tire and gouge marks left by Unit #1 post impact. The area of impact was also identified and marked. Biological material extended east from the area of impact and notable areas were marked for photography.

Using our Trimble GNSS surveying equipment, I captured the marked areas along with reference and control points. Areas of the roadway were also captured. After GNSS points were collected, I collected several 3D scans using our Trimble 3D scanner.

After scans were collected, I remained on scene and assisted as needed until

On 4/23/2024, at 0945 hours, I responded to the Gilbert Police Property and Evidence vehicle lot to serve a search warrant (SW2024-058979) for the 2012 Ford F250 and 2017 Hyundai Elantra.

Due to the Hyundai Elantra damage, the ACM module had to be removed from the vehicle for a benchtop image later at the station once the correct ACM cable was obtained. The module was secured into Gilbert Police Property and Evidence as evidence pending imaging.

While serving the search on the 2012 Ford F250, I located an EscortMax Cam within the vehicle's passenger compartment. This dashboard camera appeared to have previously been installed on the vehicle. The EscortMax Cam was removed from the Ford F250 before the ACM was successfully imaged using the department Bosch CDR system.

The EscortMax Cam was secured in the Traffic Investigation Unit evidence locker pending an additional search warrant being drafted to obtain any video evidence saved on the device or exterior SD card. The imaged ACM data from the Ford F250 was obtained and uploaded to evidence.com.

Photographs were taken during the search warrant documenting the imaging process and module removal. The photographs were uploaded to evidence.com.



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On 4/24/2024 at 0933 hours, a second search warrant (SW2024-059150) was obtained and served to copy any video files from the EscortMax Cam. A total of 14 video files were copied from the exterior SD card. The last video file, located on 4/18/2024, could not be viewed. Due to the data containing data, I requested the video file and SD card be sent to our Digital Forensic Unit to

see if they could be viewed. All video files were uploaded to evidence.com. The EscortMax Cam was secured into Property and Evidence pending the analysis. Photographs taken during the process were uploaded to evidence.com.

Ring Doorbell [REDACTED]:

The first video ([REDACTED]) reviewed came from a doorbell camera on a resident's residence at [REDACTED]. The residence is located on the southeast corner of S. Recker Road and E. Cooley Loop Road. The front door faces south towards E. Williams Field Road, and the camera footage provided captures video and audio of the collision. The video file provided was approximately 2:07.89 in length.

When the video file began, I observed a single vehicle traveling west on Williams Field Road, passing the Verde District Shops. As the vehicle passes the two-story office building just east of S. Verde St, it can no longer be seen.

At approximately 13.79 seconds in the video, another westbound vehicle on Williams Field appears in the frame. As this westbound vehicle reaches the storefronts just east of the two-story officer building, an eastbound vehicle is seen entering the frame at 17.68 seconds. The eastbound vehicle travels faster than the westbound vehicle as it passes the two-story office building.

At approximately 19.58 seconds, a third vehicle is seen in the frame, passing the Verde District Shops traveling westbound on Williams Field Road.

At approximately 19.88 seconds, the eastbound fast-moving vehicle passes the



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first westbound car, which appears to slow moments before they pass just east of the two-story office building.

At approximately 21.38 seconds, the eastbound and second westbound vehicles appear to collide. This is based on the second westbound vehicle stopping and

no longer being seen moving across the footage. The eastbound vehicle continues on Williams Field and appears to rotate due to the headlight disappearing in the footage. Additionally, a large cloud of dust and sparks can be seen trailing behind the eastbound car. Audio is captured in the video, which consists of the sound of a fast-moving vehicle moments before a loud crash and the sound of a vehicle sliding.

At approximately 23.18 seconds, the eastbound vehicle is no longer seen and appears to have passed through the intersection of Williams Field and Recker Roads.

At approximately 2 minutes and 1.50 seconds, the first arriving Gilbert Police vehicle is seen arriving eastbound on Williams Field Road.

Verde Shopping Videos:

Building E Cam 1

The first video reviewed, which was received from the property management company of Verde Shopping Center, was located on the west wall of building E. Approximately 380 feet west of Recker Road, there is a private driveway called El Paseo, which intersects with E. Williams Field Road. The camera footage captures the driveway entrance and all lanes of Williams Field Road. The video file provided is approximately 1:00.04 in length.

At approximately 1.25 seconds, a small silver SUV-style vehicle (NFI) is seen entering the frame and appears to be traveling west on Williams Field Road. This silver SUV leaves the frame at 5.83 seconds and is still westbound on Williams Field Road.

At approximately 18.92 seconds (2:01.37 AM), a blue SUV (NFI) is seen entering the frame and traveling westbound on Williams Field Road. As the blue SUV (NFI) passes the private driveway, its brake lamps activate while it slows and appears to pull to the right.



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At approximately 21.08 seconds (2:01:40 AM), a set of headlights appeared in the westbound lanes of Williams Field Road, and a white quad cab truck was seen traveling eastbound in the westbound lanes. In the frame, I could observe the center-raised median south of the white truck as it passed the blue SUV (NFI). As the white quad cab truck passes the private driveway, it is still traveling eastbound in the westbound lanes of Williams Field Road.

At approximately 22.54 seconds (2:01.41 AM), the white quad-cab truck has passed the driveway and is no longer seen in the video. The blue SUV (NFI) continues west on Williams Field Road, leaving the scene.

The remainder of the video captures no other vehicles traveling on Williams Field Road or any additional evidence related to the collision.

Building H/I, Cam 2

The second video reviewed, which was received by the property management company of Verde Shopping Center, was located on the east wall of building H/I. The camera captures a parking lot located on the southwest corner of the intersection of Williams Field and Recker Roads along with the intersection. The video file provided is approximately 59 seconds in length.

When the video begins, a light-colored SUV (NFI) travels westbound on Williams Field, passing through the intersection with Recker before leaving the frame at 5.17 seconds (2:01:14 AM).

At approximately 19.96 seconds (2:01:27 AM), two southbound vehicles are seen stopping on Recker Road before the vehicle in the curb lane makes a right turn and leaves the frame westbound on Williams Field Rd. The vehicle that turned right appears to be a smaller blue SUV (NFI) and matches the same vehicle observed in the previous video.

A pair of headlights appear at approximately 21.96 seconds (2:01:30 AM), and a westbound vehicle is seen entering the intersection at approximately 25.87 seconds (2:01:34 AM). As this vehicle passed through the intersection, it appeared to be a small red sedan that matched the victim's vehicle. The red



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sedan (victim's vehicle) leaves the frame at 28.25 seconds (2:01:37 AM).

At approximately 34.96 seconds (2:01:43 AM), a vehicle is seen entering the frame on Williams Field Road. The vehicle faces north but slides east across the intersection, leaving behind a large cloud of dust and sparks. The vehicle seen sliding east across the intersection matched the suspect vehicle found at the collision scene and came to rest at the exact location found when officers arrived.

At approximately 42.37 seconds (2:01:51 AM), the collision event had concluded, and the second southbound vehicle was seen pulling over to the southwest corner of the intersection.

EscortMax Cam:

On 4/24/2024 at 0933 hours, a second search warrant (SW2024-059150) was obtained and served to copy any video files from the EscortMax Cam. A total of 14 video files were found related to events occurring on 4/17/2024. The video files had been labeled from [REDACTED] through [REDACTED]. Additionally some of the videos provide geographic coordinate system information.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 00:17:11AM hours traveling east on US RT 60 before turning north onto Mountain View Road in Apache Junction. The video ends at 00:22:10AM with the Ford F250 continuing north on Mountain View Road.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 00:22:10AM hours traveling north onto Mountain View Road in Apache Junction. At 00:23:15AM the Ford F250 pulls to the right side of the roadway before stopping a turning its headlamps off. The Ford F250 stopped on the east shoulder of N Mountain View Road approximately 548 feet south of E. Superstition Blvd in Apache Junction when the video ends at 00:27:10AM.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 00:27:10AM until 00:28:27AM remaining stationary on the shoulder of S. Mountain View Road.



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Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 01:03:34AM still stationary before continuing north on Mountain View at 01:03:58AM. The Ford F250 makes a right turn onto E. Superstition Blvd and continues east to a private residence where it stops facing a large garage at 01:06:50AM. The location data provided shows the address as [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]. Using Google satellite imagery from 2024, I was able to determine the Ford F250 was facing east when it stopped. The Ford F250 remained stopped until the video ended at 01:08:33AM.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 01:08:33AM still stationary at 630 N. Charlebois Road, Apache Junction until the video ends at 01:12:21AM.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 01:22:45AM still stationary at [REDACTED] until the video ends at 01:23:15AM. During this video, the vehicle running lights flash believed to occurred when the vehicle was locked remotely.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 03:45:13AM still stationary at [REDACTED] until the video ends at 03:45:41AM. During the video the sun can be seen rising in the east. The listed time for sunrise on 4/17/2024 in Apache Junction was 05:37 AM.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 03:53:54AM still stationary at [REDACTED] until the video ends at 03:54:24AM. During the video the sun can be seen rising in the east.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 07:52:59AM still stationary at [REDACTED] until the video ends at 07:53:29AM. During the video the sun is overhead.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 08:39:52PM stationary in the parking lot of Top Golf located at 1689 S. Santan Village Pkwy in Gilbert, AZ. At 08:40:28PM, Harrison Ward approaches the passenger front corner of the Ford F250 while speaking with an unknown subject. Harrison



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Ward remains standing and talking to the unknown male while leaning on the passenger side front fender of his truck. While talking and manipulating his cellphone, Harrison at times moves away from the truck fender and appears to be swaying while standing. At 08:42:24PM, Harrison appears to knock his cellphone out of his hands causing it to fall to the parking lot. At 08:42:56PM, Harrison is seen walking in front of his truck towards the driver's side where leaves camera view before he is heard opening the door at 08:43:48PM. At 08:44:37PM, the Ford F250 headlights are activated, and vehicle appears to be placed into gear based on the seatbelt warning tone being activate in the audio. The video ends at 08:44:42PM with the Ford F250 running while stilled parked in the parking lot of Top Golf.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 08:44:43PM until 08:44:59PM still running and parked in the TopGolf parking lot.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 08:44:59PM still running and parked in the TopGolf parking lot. At 08:45:13PM, the passenger side window is lowered, and Harrison is heard speaking with the driver of the white truck parked next to him. At 08:45:34PM, Harrison is heard first saying,

"I'm trying to find my phone" before repeating the same statement again louder. During the audio recording, Harrison appeared to have slurred and lethargic speech. At 08:46:19PM, the Ford F250 begins to move forward as male voice from outside the Ford F250 asks, "Sandbar?" Harrison replies, "Fuck yeah!" as he begins to turn left towards the parking lot exit. The unknown male states, "Alright, I'll meet you there." At 08:46:31PM, the Ford F250 is seen approaching the parking lot exit of Top Golf onto S. Santan Village Pkwy. Once the Ford F250 exits the parking lot, it drives across all northbound lanes of

Santan Village Pkwy before driving over the center raised median and continuing into the southbound lanes. The Ford F250 is captured traveling south on S. Santan Village Pkwy during which time it can be seen drifting out of the number one lane on multiple occasions before changing into the curb lane as it approached E. Williams Field Road. After stopping for a red signal, the Ford F250 continues across Williams Field Road where it first turns into a bus stop before turning into the driveway located south of the Sandbar. The Ford F250 drove around the Sandbar parking lot before parking in the seconds row of

spaces at 08:49:54PM. The video ends at 08:49:59PM with the Ford F250 parked in the parking lot of the Sandbar Mexican Grill located at 1975 E. Williams Field Rd, Gilbert.



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Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 08:50:03PM parked in the Sandbar Mexican Grill parking lot. At 08:50:37PM the Ford F250 was turned off and Harrison could be heard saying, "I had to hop that median right there." Harrison can be seen walking away from his truck towards the Sandbar while speaking with the unknown male. At 08:51:27PM, Harrison is seen entering the Sandbar Mexican Grill using the west door. The video ends at 08:54:59PM with the Ford F250 still parked in the parking lot of the Sandbar Mexican Grill located at 1975 E. Williams Field Rd, Gilbert.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 08:55:00PM until 08:59:42PM still parked in the Sandbar Mexican Grill parking lot.

Video [REDACTED] through [REDACTED] captures movement occurring in front of the Ford F250 while still parked in the Sandbar Mexican Grill parking lot. The video files captured only unrelated vehicles moving in the parking lot between 09:04:04PM through 10:07:16PM.

Video [REDACTED] captures the Ford F250 on 4/17/2024 @ 11:54:53PM parked in the Sandbar Mexican Grill parking lot and Harrison can be seen

approaching the vehicle. A known male is seen walking back towards the business while Harrison leaves the camera frame. At 11:55:05PM, the sound of the driver's side door opening is heard along with vehicle engine being turned on. At 11:55:34PM, the sound of water pouring into the parking lot is heard, which is believed to be Harrison urinated near the open door of his truck. At 11:56:20PM the door is heard to be closed and Harrison is heard breathing in making noises before turning on the radio. At 11:58:56PM, the Ford F250 is begins driving through the parking lot and passes the west facing door of the Sandbar Mexican Grill. The Ford F250 continued pass the business towards the exit driveway where he made a left towards Santan Village Pkwy. At 11:59:42PM, the Ford F250 is seen failing to stop at the private drive stop sign before making a left turn into the southbound lanes of S. Santan Village Pkwy. The Ford F250 continues north in the southbound lanes of S. Santan Village Pkwy as

it approaches the intersection with E. Williams Field. The Ford F250 appears to enter the intersection on a red signal while beginning to make a right turn before the video ends at 11:59:50PM.

After reviewing the videos obtained from the EscortMax Cam, it was determined



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that the timestamp was two hours behind in all video files. This was confirmed by video evidence in Video [REDACTED] and Video [REDACTED], showing the sun had risen even though the time stamp stated it was 03:45 AM, nearly two hours before the listed sunrise for Apache Junction, AZ. The receipts obtained from Top Golf show Harrison Ward closed his tap at approximately 10:06 PM before Video [REDACTED] captures him leaving

1689 S. Santan Village Pkwy at 8:46 PM, which is nearly two hours before. Video [REDACTED] showed Harrison walking into the Sandbar with his coworker, Brady Argyle (NFI), at 08:51 PM, nearly two hours before Brady opened a tap at 10:58 PM.

All receipts obtained related to transactions from Top Golf and Sandbar Mexican Grill and flock images were uploaded to evidence.com.

Video and Reconstruction Conclusion:

The collision reconstruction showed Harrison Ward went to Top Golf at 1689 S. Santan Village Pkwy in Gilbert, AZ, at around 06:45 PM. This was based on a reservations and Flock camera photos showing his vehicle northbound on Santan Village at 6:35 PM on 4/17/2024.

At approximately 10:46 PM on 4/17/2024, Harrison had exited the parking lot onto the northbound lanes of Santan Village Pkwy before crossing all lanes and driving over the center-raised median. Harrison continued driving south on S. Santan Village Pkwy, where dash camera footage shows him drifting out of his

lane multiple times before turning right into the Sandbar Mexican Grill at 1975 E. Williams Field Rd, Gilbert, at 8:50 PM on 4/17/2024.

At 01:54 AM on 4/18/2024, Harrison was seen exiting the Sandbar Mexican Grill before entering and starting his Ford F250, which was still parked at 1975 E. Williams Field Rd. After urinating outside of his open driver's side door, Harrison is seen driving through the parking lot towards the east parking lot exit.

At 1:59 AM on 4/18/2024, Harrison exits the Sandbar Mexican Grill parking lot and turns north into the southbound lanes of S. Santan Village Pkwy. He then drives north in the southbound lanes towards E. Williams Field Road, where he makes a wide radius right turn into the westbound lanes of Williams Field Road and continues east in the westbound lanes.



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Between 1:59 AM and 2:01 AM, Harrison was recklessly driving east in the westbound lanes of E. Williams Field for approximately 2.35 miles at speeds ranging from 117 to 127 mph. During this time, Patrick Wheeler, who had been traveling west on Williams Field near S. Higley Road, had to make two evasive lane changes to avoid being struck by Harrison's vehicle that was eastbound in the westbound lanes of Williams Field Road.

At 2:01 AM on 4/18/2024, Harrison is still traveling east in the westbound lanes of E. Williams Field Road when he is seen passing a private driveway called El Paseo, which intersects with E. Williams Field Road. At this time, the driver of a small blue SUV (NFI) had to make an evasive lane change to avoid being struck by Harrison, who was still traveling between 117 to 127 mph eastbound in the westbound lanes of E. Williams Field Road.

At 02:02 AM on 4/18/2024, Harrison's reckless driving culminated when he impacted a 2017 Hyundai Elantra, driven by Anastasia Dombrowski, that was traveling westbound on E. Williams Field Road at 25 to 35 mph. The impact was

severe, with Harrison operating his Ford F250 at speeds between 117 to 127 mph. This resulted in his Ford truck plowing through and over Anastasia's vehicle

before sliding for 518.74 feet along E. Williams Field Road. While sliding east on Williams Field Road, Harrison also struck a Town of Gilbert streetlamp support pole while crossing over the center median. Harrison finally came to a stop in the westbound lanes of E. Williams Field just east of S. Recker Road where he was found by an officer still in the driver's seat.

The posted speed limit for E. Williams Field Road is 45 mph from S. Santan Village Pkwy until S. Wade where it decreases to 35 mph where the collision occurred. The investigation showed that Harrison was operating his 2012 Ford F250 at speed more than 82 to 92 mph over the posted 35 mph speed limit while traveling against traffic when he struck a Hyundai Elantra that was driving under the posted limit causing the death of the driver, Anastasia Dombrowski.

Due to the mathematical equations being unable to be viewed in the Versaterm software, all calculations were attached to the report using an AZDOT supplement form.

This case remains active pending further investigation.

It was requested that I review the file to see if any video of the incident was recoverable or could be repaired so it could be reviewed by the case detective. It was explained to me that the file (s) provided to me were a forensic copy of the original source media from a micro SD card contained within the dash camera reference a vehicle collision. A search of this evidence item was conducted by Duncan pursuant to a search warrant.

I requested a second usable/playable video file be provided from the dash camera system if available. Zach Duncan provided me with the following file (by name):

I identified the files as .MOV files the pre-defined signatures on both files were observed as ftyp ([REDACTED]) which defines QuickTime Container file type. The File sub type is qt ([REDACTED]) which points to a MOV file type. Both files showed the same type of file. A review of each files original

Summary of .mov.

A .MOV file consists of several atoms or section. The ftyp atom contains information about the standards that the file conforms to. It is the structure of the file / container.

The Mdat atom consists of the media data, both video and audio. This is the section the contains the source of what the user can view.

The Moov atom is the instructions for the video and audio. This atom contains information to tell the computer or device where to find the data and tell system how to use it.



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Summary of corrections to corrupt file:

I reviewed both files using WinHex version 21.1 and HxD version 2.3.0.0 hex editing tools. Copies of the original files provided by Zach Duncan were used for this editing of the files. The original source media nor the forensic copy of source media was used for any editing.

While reviewing files [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] it was observed the [REDACTED] file was missing the moov atom / section.

This could have been caused by a number of factors to include improper shutdown of a device during recording, device malfunction or possibly other factors during the write process to the listed evidence items memory.

Reviewing the file [REDACTED], I was able to identify the moov atom/section of file and it was located intact and function correctly to play the above mentioned file without issue.

The moov atom was used from the file [REDACTED] to correct the missing moov atom which did not exist in the original [REDACTED].MOV file. This hex was used to replace the missing data. The block size to locate sections of the file was edited to correspond with the file [REDACTED]

The corrected file is not an exact duplicate of the original source media. This files data was edited to make the mdat data reviewable.

The mdat data from the edited video is in fact a duplicate of the original source media. This is the part of the file that contains the video and audio data. This was validated by exporting the bytes from each mdat section of the files and reviewed showing they were the same.

I reviewed the video to ensure the video would be viewable for the case detective. The video played without issue. The video to include the timestamp was consistent with previous video file [REDACTED]. It appears as video file [REDACTED] is the next video in continuation of video file [REDACTED]. The corrected video file includes audio and video of a vehicle collision.



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Once I completed the corrections to the file it was saved as

[REDACTED] and provided back to Zach Duncan for his review and analysis.

The original Encase image was processed using X-ways forensics and unallocated space was carved to see if the video had possibly been deleted. No further data was observed in unallocated space indicating the video may have been deleted.

This concludes my involvement in this case.

Such as start end of file, what codec to use for recording/playback, how many video tracks, how many audio tracks, among other information. moov atom does not contain the actual recorded video just vital information related to that video. It appears that likely due to abrupt removal of power from the dash cam the moov atom and metadata within that moov atom was not completed in the files structure. The actual recorded video is located within a different container within the file structure called the "mdat" atom.

-HxD (hex-metadata viewer/editor) version 2.3.0.0 was used to view the hex metadata of file [REDACTED].

-moov atom was not present in the files metadata.

-a functioning file from the same dash camera micro-SD card

([REDACTED]) was copied and examined in HxD to isolate the moov atom and the metadata that moov atom contains. [REDACTED] was chosen

On 5/20/2024, I received the Maricopa County Medical Examiner report related to OME case 24-03982, Anastasia Louis Dombrowski's examination on 4/16/2024 at 0920 hours. The report stated the following:

 - A. Multiple skull fractures with traumatic avulsion of brain.
 - B. Left humerus fracture.
 - C. Bilateral rib fractures.
 - D. Bilateral hemothoraces.
 - E. Bilateral femur fractures.
 - F. Right tibia and fibula fracture.
 - G. Multiple abrasions, contusions, and lacerations.

II. Postmortem toxicology negative.

The cause of death: Blunt force trauma

Manner of death: Accident

How injury occurred: Driver in motor vehicle crash

An additional odontology report was provided, documenting a dental examination conducted to identify Anastasia Dombrowski positively.

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Further Video Analysis:

Sandbar Mexican Grill CCTV

On 5/21/2024, I received eighteen video files from Agent L. Crance #58 with the Arizona Department of Liquor and Control. Agent Crance conducted separate investigations related to TopGolf (24-000632) and Sandbar Mexican Grill (24-000717). Agent Crance provided me with copies of receipts and all CCTV footage obtained related to Harrison Ward's inactions while at the establishments. All the CCTV footage was uploaded to evidence.com.

The following is a summary of what was seen after reviewing the provided CCTV footage from the Gilbert Sandbar Mexican Grill located at 1975 E. Williams Field Road between 4/17/2024 at 2240 hours and 4/18/2024 at 0300 hours. Harrison is first captured on 4/17/2024 at 2248 hours, driving through the

parking lot before parking and exiting his truck at 2250 hours. Harrison enters the Sandbar through the front door and passes the hostess desk at 2251 hours. Harrison is seen sitting at the north patio bar before ordering a mixed drink at 2258 hours while his friend orders a beer bottle. Harrison is seen ordering

additional drinks while sitting at the north patio bar. Starting at 0129 hours, Harrison gets out of this chair several times, appearing to have trouble standing. At one point, Harrison falls backwards over a bar chair, landing on the floor. At 0149 hours, bar employees interact with Harrison before he

appears to get involved in a physical altercation with the bar security at 0151 hours. The altercation results in Harrison falling backward to the floor and the bar security holding him down. Less than a minute later, Harrison is seen being escorted by bar security out of the building at 0152 hours. Harrison is seen walking towards his truck, being assisted by his friend. At 0155 hours, Harrison opens the driver's side door of his truck while his friend returns to the building. The truck's headlights are on, and the driver's side door closes

before Harrison is seen driving north through the parking lot and turning south towards the Santan Village Pkwy driveway exit. Harrison turns left towards Santan Village and quickly accelerates out of the parking lot at 0159 hours.

The CCTV footage provided coincides with the bar receipt provided by Agent Crance. It shows that Harrison's friend, Brady Argyle, purchased six Captain Morgan cocktails and three beers between 4/17/24 at 1058 hours and 4/18/24 at 0135 hours. Harrison is seen drinking mixed drinks, while Brady is seen



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drinking bottled beer. The footage also shows that the Harrison truck's dash camera footage time stamps were incorrectly set.

Dash Camera Video [REDACTED]:

On 6/6/2024, I was notified by the Gilbert PD Forensic Lab that the video file [REDACTED] had been fixed and was able to be viewed. (See Det. Meile and Analyst Duncan's supplement reports for details.)

The video begins as the Ford F250 travels north in the southbound lanes of Santan Village Pkwy and makes a wide radius right turn into the westbound lanes of E. Williams Field Road on a red traffic signal. The Ford F250 travels east in the westbound lanes of E. Williams Field Road while swerving across the lanes as it approaches the freeway overpass. The Ford F250 begins to accelerate as it passes over the freeway, still traveling eastbound in the westbound lanes of Williams Field. As the Ford F250 reaches S. Higley Road, it travels at a high rate of speed while closing in on an approaching vehicle in the middle lane. As the Ford F250 crosses the railroad tracks, it narrowly misses colliding with a westbound truck, which appears to have made an evasive maneuver to avoid it. The Ford F250 continues east in the westbound number one lane, approaching a second vehicle (NFI), which also makes an evasive maneuver into the middle lane to avoid the Ford F250 just west of S. Verde. A third vehicle (blue SUV seen in Verde CCTV) traveling westbound in the number one lane also makes an evasive maneuver to avoid the Ford 250 still traveling east in the westbound number one lane. Less than two seconds later, the Ford F250 was seen impacting the victim's vehicle, which was westbound on the number one lane.

The video file [REDACTED] confirms that Harrison Ward traveled east in the westbound lanes of E. Williams Field Road for approximately 1 minute and 46 seconds, covering 2.35 miles from S. Santan Village to the Area of impact (AOI). Additionally, it identified an additional citizen vehicle (NFI) that had to make an evasive lane change to avoid being struck by Harrison's vehicle.



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Lab Results:

On 5/22/2024, the Mesa Police Department Forensic Services Unit provided a toxicology scientific examination report related to a drug screen conducted on the blood sample collected from Harrison Ward. The analysis of the blood showed it to contain no drug classes.

On 6/10/2024, the Mesa Police Department Forensic Services Unit provided a toxicology scientific examination report related to a BAC screen conducted on the blood sample collected from Harrison Ward.

The report showed the following:

ITEMS:

GI26982-1 (001): One blood collection kit
GI26982-1-AA (001-AA): Blood specimen
GI26982-1-AB (001-AB): Blood Specimen: Received, not analyzed.

RESULTS:

(001-AA): Analysis of the Blood specimen showed it to contain 0.238 +/- 0.012 (gram of ethyl alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood) at a level of confidence greater than 99.73%.

All videos and evidence was uploaded to evidence.com before this additional supplement reports were forwarded to the Maricopa County Attorney's Office.

The case remains cleared by arrest.

-To my knowledge the timeline video request was for presentation purposes.

All the Sandbar CCTV videos are from the same system so are the Verde CCTV. The dash camera time stamp is off by approximately two hours. Some of the video clip timeframes above capture the same events from different cameras. If

possible, having those timeframes split screen would be wonderful, if possible. The highlighted files are same time different camera for the entire file. This way the video is somewhat shorter in overall length.

The following is the order of combining of all video evidence related to the suspect actions.

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Software Programs Used:

-Amped FIVE version 33279 - Forensic Video/Image Analysis/enhancement program that is widely used in the field of forensic video analysis. In this case used for arranging multiple videos in chronological order and concatenating them together into a single linear video. Also used to select a range of time for each video to include in chronological timeline. This range of time selected was heavily based off the above listed edit list.

-Adobe premier Pro version 2023 - Professional nonlinear video/audio editor. In this case used to create a side by side for certain videos to be viewed simultaneously as well as time edits.

Examination Protocol and Results:

06-17-24

-Files listed in the above request were downloaded from evidence.com and copied onto forensic workstation.

-There is a total of 20 videos that were downloaded.

06-23-24 through 6-27-24

-The 20 video files were imported into an Amped FIVE project.

-Within the Amped FIVE project filters were used to select a range of frames to include requested portions of video, convert frame rate for linked timeline, and to render a new timeline video.

-The videos from multiple video surveillance sources, dash cam, and ring camera were of different frame rates. In order to have consistent playback all 20 videos frame rate was converted to 29.97 FPS for all videos. This conversion does not change playback speed but may add duplicate frames to a lower frame rate video or take away P or B frames from a higher frame rate video.

-MP4 output filter settings were h.264 codec to maximize compatibility and default quality to maintain manageable file sizes.

-A full timeline video was successfully rendered from Amped FIVE.

-After this each individual video with a timeline range selected was rendered



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from Amped FIVE to load into a Adobe Premier pro project. This was done to use Premier pro to create a timeline with side by side views of multiple camera angles simultaneously.

-The individual videos were loaded into a Premier pro project and the side-by-side camera views were created by resizing two camera angles and stacking the video angles in the timeline of premier pro so they would be showing at the same time.

-The timeline video with side-by-side angles was exported from premier pro with identical file container, codec, video quality and frame rate.

-Another version of this timeline video with side by side was exported with time of subjects at the bar edited out to make the video shorter for presentation purposes.

-The Premier pro project was saved in the working folder for this case. Also Amped FIVE project reports were generated to document filters/settings used in those projects to render the mentioned timeline videos.

-Ultimately three timeline videos were created. File names are listed below.

-GI24-55137 full timeline_V1.mp4 [REDACTED]

-GI24-55137_full timeline_side by side.mp4 [REDACTED]

-GI24-55137_time at bar edited.mp4 [REDACTED]

All files were then hashed using a hashing algorithm program called Hasher (v 2.0). This is done to show the files identity. While this does not illustrate

the contents of a file it does reveal the unique identity of a file. This helps ensure that we know the identity of the files being reviewed.

-The derived files GI24-55137 full timeline_V1.mp4, GI24-55137_full timeline_side by side.mp4, GI24-55137_time at bar edited.mp4 have a data size that totals 101 GB. Requester notified via email on 6-27-24 of derived videos completion and a USB drive with at least 120GB of space was requested to impound derived videos.

All projects and derived videos were also backed up on the DFU Server.



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This ended my involvement with this case at this time.

Being the victim of a crime can be traumatic. You may feel isolated and confused, and not know where to turn for practical advice or support. This brochure highlights resources available to assist you and explains your rights as a victim under Arizona law.

AGENCIES & SERVICES

See *"Information and Resource Numbers"* on the last page for a list of agencies that can provide victim assistance services.

PROTECTIVE ORDERS

A protective order is a civil court order issued by a judge or magistrate that prohibits a defendant from contacting you or coming in contact with you. Any county court in the State of Arizona can review the petition and issue an order. An order of protection is valid for two (2) years after it is served. There are no fees for filing or serving an order. The types of orders you can request are:

1. **Order of Protection:** This type of order requires a qualifying relationship. You can fill out forms and figure out if you have a qualifying relationship through AZPOINT.
2. **Injunction Against Harassment:** If you do not have a qualifying relationship, victims of certain crimes may be eligible for this type of order. A service fee may apply. You can fill out forms through AZPOINT.
3. **Emergency Order of Protection:** This type of order is intended to protect individuals in immediate and present danger. To obtain an EOP, contact law enforcement. These orders expire seven (7) calendar days after issuance.
4. **Injunction Against Workplace Harassment:** A service fee may apply. You can fill out forms through AZPOINT.

If you are a party in an ongoing or pending family law case (ex. dissolution of marriage) or if the juvenile defendant is under the age of twelve, you must apply at any Superior Court location. To start the protective order process, go to <https://azpoint.azcourts.gov/>

Your employer may be legally required to allow you leave from work to attend court and to obtain an order of protection pursuant to ARS §§ 13-4439/8-420.



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DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

If you have been a victim of domestic violence, you may seek a protective order. For more information on protective orders, please refer to the "Protective Orders" section above.

If there is a firearm present when there has been an incident of domestic violence and a law enforcement officer believes that the firearm would expose the victim or another person in the household to a risk of serious bodily injury or death, the firearm may be temporarily seized and held by the law enforcement agency. To ensure that you, as the victim, are notified of the release of a firearm that has been seized, you must provide the law enforcement agency with any change of address or phone number.

SEXUAL ASSAULT

If you have been a victim of a dangerous crime against children as defined in ARS § 13-705 or a sexual assault, you are entitled to a medical or forensic interview free of charge, without reporting to law enforcement, paid by the county in which the offense occurred pursuant to ARS § 13-1414.

ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY PROGRAM

The Arizona Address Confidentiality Program (ACP) is a program that helps victims of domestic violence, sexual offenses, and/or stalking from being located by the perpetrator through public records. The program provides a substitute address and confidential mail forwarding services to individuals and families across Arizona.

VICTIM COMPENSATION

If you are a victim of a crime or the next of kin of a victim who died as a result of a criminal act, you may be eligible for compensation. To obtain an application or to receive more information on Crime Victim Compensation, contact your county Victim Compensation Coordinator.

VICTIMS' RIGHTS

As a victim of crime in Arizona, you have a Constitutional right to be treated with fairness, respect and dignity and to be free from intimidation, harassment or abuse throughout the criminal or juvenile justice process. All state, county and municipal justice agencies and courts in Arizona are required to perform certain duties to ensure that you receive your rights.

WHO IS A VICTIM FOR PURPOSES OF EXERCISING RIGHTS?

State law says a victim is a person against whom a criminal or juvenile offense has been committed. This includes any felony, misdemeanor, petty offense or violation of a local criminal ordinance. If a person is killed or incapacitated, the person's spouse, parent, child, sibling, grandparent or any other person related to the person by consanguinity or affinity to the second degree or any other lawful representative of the person, except if that person is in custody for an offense or is the accused, may receive victims' rights. If a victim is incapacitated, deceased or otherwise incapable of designating another person to act in the victim's place, the court may appoint a lawful representative who is not a witness. If at any time the victim is no longer incapacitated or otherwise incapable of acting, the victim may personally exercise his or her victim's rights.



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REQUESTING/WAIVING RIGHTS

The law enforcement officer provided you with a form (Request/Waiver Form) that asks you to request or waive (decline) your rights. This form will assist you in exercising your victims' rights, whether you decide to request or waive your rights. Keep your copy of the form for your records. Your decision to request or waive your rights does not mean that you cannot change your mind later. However, if at first you waive your rights and then request them at a later time, you will be giving up some rights that only apply at certain stages of the justice process. There are other important benefits and protections that apply to crime victims as a case proceeds through the system. If you choose to waive your rights, it does not exclude your involvement in the prosecution of the case. You may be subpoenaed to testify in court.

YOUR RIGHT TO RESTITUTION

Victims of crime have a Constitutional right to receive prompt restitution. If someone is found guilty of the crime(s) committed against you, the court may order that person to re-pay certain financial costs related to your victimization. This court-ordered payment is known as restitution. Restitution is most often ordered at the time of sentencing and may include reimbursement for actual losses and expenses attributable to the offense. To determine the amount of restitution to be ordered, financial loss information is gathered from victims prior to sentencing. If you have faced financial losses as a result of the crime committed against you, it is recommended that you keep track of all your receipts as expenses are incurred. If charges are filed in your case, it is important that you contact the prosecutor's Victim Services program for more information and assistance with the restitution process.

FREE COPIES OF POLICE REPORTS & VIDEO RECORDINGS

A victim of a criminal offense that is a part 1 crime (e.g. criminal homicide, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, motor vehicle theft, larceny-theft and arson), an immediate family member of the victim if the victim is killed or incapacitated, or the victim's attorney has the right to receive one copy of the police report and video recordings from the investigating law enforcement agency at no charge.

WHEN A SUSPECT IS ARRESTED

Box 3 of the Request/Waiver Form provides information to assist you in exercising your rights immediately following the arrest of a suspect; however, you must act quickly. See next page for the specific scenarios outlining your rights as a victim.

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SUSPECT IS AN ADULT AND HAS BEEN ARRESTED

If the suspect is an adult and has been arrested, law enforcement informed you of the time, place and date of the Initial Appearance. You are encouraged to contact the court for any changes to the Initial Appearance schedule. For any questions about the suspect's release, contact the custodial agency.

Initial Appearance (Court Hearing)

Purposes: (1) Determine release eligibility of the accused;
(2) Determine the terms and conditions of release of the accused;
(3) Set the next court date(s);
(4) Obtain a plea from the accused (for some misdemeanor offenses)

When Held: Within 24 hours of arrest

Location: Court and Custodial Agency

Contact: See "Information & Resource Numbers"

Your Rights: To be notified of the time, place and date for the Initial Appearance, to be present and heard at the Initial Appearance and to be informed of the suspect's release.

SUSPECT IS A JUVENILE AND HAS BEEN DETAINED

If the suspect is a juvenile and has been detained, you must contact the detention screening section of the juvenile probation department immediately to request notice of the date, time and place of the Detention Hearing and any changes to the Detention Hearing schedule. You can also exercise your right to be informed of the juvenile's release by contacting the detention center.

Detention and Advisory Hearings

Purposes: (1) Determine release eligibility of the accused;
(2) If the accused is released, determine the terms and conditions of release;
(3) Obtain a plea from the juvenile
(4) Juvenile to admit guilt or deny

When Held: Detention Hearing – within 24 hours of arrest
Advisory Hearing – within 24 hours of detention hearing

Location: Detention Screening Section, County Juvenile Probation

Contact: See "Information & Resource Numbers"

Your Rights: To be notified of the time, place and date for the detention and advisory hearings, to be present and heard at the detention and advisory hearings and to be informed of the juvenile's release.

If you choose to exercise your right to be heard through a written statement, contact the detention screening section for instructions on how to submit to the court.

SUSPECT IS AN ADULT OR JUVENILE AND CITED AND RELEASED

If an adult suspect is cited and released, law enforcement informed you of the initial court date. *If a juvenile suspect is cited and released*, law enforcement has provided you with the name of the court to obtain information about subsequent proceedings. Contact the court prior to the date and time to confirm that the suspect must appear.

SUSPECT IS AN ADULT OR JUVENILE AND THERE IS NO ARREST

If the arrest of a suspect is not immediate and you are not notified of an arrest within 30 days, you can call the law enforcement agency that took the report to obtain case status information.
